October 15, 2023 open enrollment for 2024 begins. December 7, 2023 open enrollment for 2024 ends. January 1, 2024 coverage begins.

Emergency Home Response Service is a 24 hour emergency communication link to assistance outside the home for older adults. This service is provided by a two-way voice communication system, with a base unit connected to a land *line telephone and a cell phone in certain circumstances. An activation device is worn by the older* adult. When activated, the older adult is automatically linked to a professionally staffed support center for assistance.

- Everyday Life: How you spend your personal time is your choice, but having a good quality of day to day activities is very achievable while in a Long Term Care Facility.
- Culture Change: This is directed to the Home's awareness and commitment to person centered/direct care. Ask about the facility's Resident Council.
- Staff turnover is a method of measuring staff satisfaction.
- Longevity of the Administrator and Director of Nursing.
- Staff to resident ratios should be compared between facilities.
- Check out the surveys from the Illinois Department of Public Health for each Long Term Care Facility that you are considering.
